Ministry Trip to Kenya updates – March 2008

These updates will give you a glimpse of what the Potter's Ministries is doing by the grace of God. We appreciate your love, prayers and financial support. Together, we can do what God has called us to do.

Highlights

- Leadership seminars on “Moving from Vision to Reality” for pastors and leaders in 4 different cities namely Nairobi, Mombasa, El Doret and Bungoma.
- Inaugurated “God’s Bible Institute” in Bungoma
- Preached at “Maximum Miracle Center,” one of the largest Churches in Nairobi with more than 3000 people in attendance
- Clippings on leadership training will be aired on Kenyan National Television

Ministry in Nairobi: Kenya was tense less than 2 weeks before the Cyril arrived at Nairobi. The Lord helped us meet with Australian missionaries who are working with orphanages. We had discussions with Rev. Waningu on teaching strategies for training leaders. Cyril greeted the audience at two locations at Maximum Miracle Center which is one of the largest Church in Nairobi. We then proceeded to the other three cities for ministry. Cyril later preached for Bishop Pius Muiru at Maximum Miracle Center with more than 3000 people in attendance. Many came forward for the altar call to pursue their God given purpose. We met with Ramesh Kennedy and Noel who are leaders in the Indian community. We had a seminar with the Asian community with 25 leaders in attendance. The prayer for repentance and reconciliation between the Asian and African community was a phenomenal one. We recorded video clippings to be played on national TV that literally reaches millions with the word of God. We met with Joyce Musungu who is the Women of Valor representative and leader in Nairobi.

Ministry in Mombasa: We landed in Mombasa on March 10th and were received by at least 15 people with flowers and greetings. The weather was very warm and humid. It was like a spiritual warfare from the spiritual perspective which we had to battle in prayer and fasting. We thank God for all the intercessors that prayed and stood in the gap. God indeed gave a fruitful ministry. A total of 40 leaders attended the leadership seminar and the attendees gave their testimonies which brought glory to God. These were Pastors from churches from different denominations. The seminar continued the next day and concluded. Greater is He that is in us than he that is in the world!

Ministry in El Doret: We took a flight to El Doret to conduct a leadership seminar on March 12th. We could see the hunger they have for God’s word. The Kenyan people are a people of prayer. They sign up for 6 hours time slots for prayer. Fasting prayers and all night prayers are very common. They worship the Lord with a great passion. Pastors from various churches and denominations had registered for the leadership seminar. Many were blessed by Cyril’s book. Praise the Lord.

Ministry in Bungoma: We were able to see the impact of the post election violence with burnt Churches and businesses when we drove to Bungoma. We had two seminars in Bungoma. The seminar with the Bungoma graduates group was attended by more than 50 people. Cyril inaugurated “God’s Bible College.” This was a humbling experience. The founders of God’s Bible Institute said that they will use Cyril’s book, “Moving from Vision to Reality” as a leadership training resource in their curriculum. About 200 people were gathered. We thank God for Rev Kennedy Waningu, the founder and chairman of Kenya Prayer Team who had coordinated all these meetings. Glory to God!
